FOUNDER (2020)

Tiffany Kirk, the founder of Project Restart, considers herself a "Social Equity Warrior". She has over 16 years experience in community development for the financial sector, over 20 years in education and financial education, and 15 years formally working with incarcerated and returning citizen youth and adult populations as a volunteer and nonprofit leader.

Her vision for Project Restart is to be a key reentry program locally in Atlanta and beyond. She understands that the key to personal success is human, educational and financial support for any demographic, but more importantly for returning citizens.

Tiffany and her team's dedication has led to the program graduate 65 adults since 2020. According to recent surveys, only 2 of the alumni of the program have faced criminal charges, one of whom faced charges of a crime committed prior to entering the program. A 4% recidivism rate is much more promising than the general recidivism rate in the state of Georgia which currently stands at greater than 30%. All alumni have begun and maintained employment, training and/or entrepreneurship ventures upon completion of the program.

With the continued operation and growth of Project Restart, these outcomes will continue. It is through the support of public and private donors that the program can operate, hence, Project Restart sources and accepts financial support on an ongoing basis.

ALUMNI SUCCESS HIGHLIGHTS

Shanard Linsey

Shanard returned home from incarceration in November 2021, after serving 26 years in prison. At that time, Shanard began his own home inspection program. Through participating in and completing Project Restart, Shanard was able to complete his business plan, greatly improve and execute his marketing strategy and purchase new equipment for his business. His brand and customer base has greatly grown since completing the 2022 program.

Sharee Jackson

Sharee Jackson, a licensed cosmetologist, entered the 2021 program while providing cosmetology services out of her home. Through a powerful mentorship experience, Sharee was encouraged to consider renting a salon suite to operate her business from. Sharee pitched for funding to begin her lease, purchase equipment and additional hair technique training and is now a successful entrepreneur.

PROGRAM OUTCOMES

- Since 2020, 65 adults have successfully completed Project Restart's 12-week program
- Project Restart has awarded over \$55,000 in micro-grants to deserving alumni
- 100% of graduates have improved thier employment, entrepreneurship or education foundation
- Within 2 years of completing the program, we have seen a 4% recidivism rate compared to the national rate of nearly 50%

COMMUNITY IMPACT

- Project Restart has cultivated relationships with over 75 nonprofit organizations, correctional facilites, government agencies and private businesses since 2020
- The program has served over nearly 300 individuals through its non-traditional programming hosting events abd providing resources and financial education in transitional housing and two correctional facilities
